1.0 Program Requirements

Golf Canada/Golf Quebec state that to compete as a junior you must be 18 years or less on as of August 1st of the playing year.

The DRGC Junior program is open to individuals aged 7-18 as of August 1st of the playing year. The junior member can participate in club tournaments, and the Junior Champion and runner-up are eligible to compete for the Club Championship. Juniors are allowed play on Intersectional teams, if they qualify.

2.0 Playing Restrictions

All players, including juniors, must check in with the pro shop staff before play. It is recommended that juniors under the age of 10 be accompanied by an adult. Adherence to the etiquette of the game is expected. Inappropriate behavior will result in suspension of playing privileges.

3.0 Tee Time Restrictions

Juniors may only reserve tee times as follows:

- Before 4:15 pm and after 7:00 pm on weekdays.
- After 2:00 pm on weekends and holidays.
- May tee off between 12:00 pm and 2:00 pm on weekends and holidays provided they are playing with an adult member who has reserved the tee time.

Juniors can check in with the pro shop on any day (for play that day) and will be assigned tee times at the pro shop's discretion.

4.0 Adult Competitions

Junior members are eligible to compete in some adult events. Consult the Junior Director for more information.

5.0 Other Restrictions

Juniors do not have a right to vote at the Deep River Golf Club.
