The Deep River Golf Course offers eight membership options each offering a set of certain specific privileges. There is also a golf pass card available through the Pro Shop that gives the individual limited playing privileges without having to become a member.

Electronic copies of all forms can be found on the **Deep River Golf Course** website under the membership tab.

A **new member** is an individual who has never been a member of the club or has not been a member for at least two consecutive years. Special progressive rates apply for the first two years culminating in the member paying full rate by the third year.

The options to choose from are defined as follows:

1) Full Adult/Senior Membership (New or returning member)

This membership option lets the member play unlimited golf providing the course is available for play. It also lets the member join a club team, participate in club events such as men's night, women's field days, men's or women's stableford, club leagues, club tournaments such as the men's, women's or mixed invitations, OVGA intersectional, and other sanctioned events, providing the member meets the requirements of such tournaments. An individual needs to be 55 years or older to qualify as a senior. The member may also take advantage of any reciprocal agreements the club has with other clubs in the valley.

2) Full Family (New or returning member)

This membership option lets the primary member, his/her spouse, and any of their children who meet the definition of junior in the family play unlimited golf providing the course is available for play. All of the privileges listed under the Full Adult/Senior Membership (New or returning member) above apply. The junior(s) privileges are listed in item 4 below.

3) Student

This option is available to individuals actively enrolled in a full-time post-secondary scholastic program. The member has all the privileges listed in the Full Adult/Senior Membership (New or returning member) above.

4) Junior

This option is available to individuals actively enrolled in primary or secondary school and open to ages 7-18 as of August 1st of the playing year. The junior member can participate in club tournaments, and the Junior Champion and runner-up are eligible to compete for the Club Championship. Juniors are allowed play on Intersectional teams, if they qualify. Juniors do not carry a right to vote at club meetings. Full details applicable to junior members are listed in DRCG Policy OP-004.

5) Corporate Membership

The Deep River Golf Club offers Corporate Memberships to companies that conducting their affairs in the local area. The primary member or guest has access to limited golf providing the course is available for play, and can participate in men's night, men's and ladies stableford, and field days. Full details of the corporate membership are listed in DRCG Policy OP-006.

6) Golf Pass Card

The following serves to define the meaning of the Golf Card Pass. A Golf Card Pass holder is **not deemed to be a "member" of the club** as defined in the club's by-laws.

The DRGC offers a Golf Pass Card that lets the holder of the pass play limited golf providing the course is available for play. The card has twenty-four punches, a nine hole round requires two punches, while an eighteen hole round requires three punches.

7) Limited Play Membership

New members, existing full members wishing to reduce their play, or former members are all eligible to apply for the limited play membership.

The limited membership lets the member play a maximum of 50 nine-hole rounds per operating season, providing the course is available for play. The member can also participate in men's night, men's or women's stableford, League A and/or B, socials, and field days.

Limited members must also sign the special information form and tracking sheet.

8) Out of Town Adult/Senior/Family

An Out of Town member is defined as someone whose permanent residence lies outside the catchment area of Deep River or Laurentian Hills. The member has all the privileges of a Full Adult/Senior/Family Membership (New or returning member) defined above. An individual needs to be 55 years or older to qualify as a senior.

9) Out of Town Junior

An Out of Town junior member is defined as someone whose permanent residence lies outside the catchment area of Deep River or Laurentian Hills. The member has all the privileges of a junior member defined above.

The table in Appendix A shows the privileges for all nine options in a graphic format.

A **new member** is an individual who has never been a member of the club or has not been a member for at least two consecutive years. Special progressive rates apply for the first two years culminating in the member paying full rate by the third year.

- 1) The tournament events and scheduled dates are listed on the Deep River Golf Club web site at deeprivergolf.ca. Juniors are permitted to participate in Junior tournaments only except that the Junior Champion and runner-up are eligible to compete for the Club Championship.
- 2) Limited Play Membership provides for a maximum of 50 nine-hole rounds per operating season. Available to new members or existing full members. Limited members must register and initial the Play Sheet with the Pro Shop prior to each round. Rounds played without prior registration will be subject to green fee charges.
- 3) Corporate membership offers 30 nine-hole rounds per playing season for use pending course availability. See Policy OP-006 for further details.
- 4) See OP-004 for junior tee time restrictions or see the Junior Director for tournament or other information.
- 5) If Family Membership includes Junior Member(s), Junior Membership rules (see note 4) apply to the Junior Member.
- 6) An Out of Town member is defined as someone whose permanent residence lies outside the catchment area of Deep River or Laurentian Hills.
- 7) Corporate Memberships carries one vote per membership. The individual named on the corporate membership or his/her proxy has the right to one vote.
