### 1.0 PURPOSE

The Deep River Golf Club recognizes that some individuals require relaxation of normal cart use rules to allow them to enjoy their round of golf through improved access, minimizing physical demands, and maintaining an appropriate pace of play. This is accommodated with the use of a red flag on their cart, provided by the DRGC Pro Shop. At the same time, red flag users are reminded of the potential damage created by carts and the resulting requirements for additional maintenance. We trust that the following guidelines will allow red flag users to continue to enjoy the game while ensuring that the course maintains the level of quality expected by members and guests.

### 2.0 PROCESS FOR OBTAINING A RED FLAG

Red flags will be provided by the Club and will be made available by the Pro Shop. For short term use, flags shall be returned to the Pro Shop on completion of the round.

Members requiring the use of a red flag for an extended period of time (more than one month) or the entire season are asked to a) hold a provincial accessible parking permit or b) provide a medical note from a doctor or c) make a short request in writing via the Pro Shop, as soon as the need is known, stating the reason for prolonged red flag use. Red flag users are responsible for retaining the flag and displaying it on the cart.

### 3.0 GUIDELINES FOR RED FLAG USERS

Except during periods when any part of the course is limited to the use of carts on path only, carts may be taken inside the limits of the fairways designated by 'No carts' signage. However, carts shall not be taken onto the sloped areas of green and tee surrounds, on green approaches, or between bunkers and the putting surface.

During certain times of the year, or during certain weather conditions, it may be necessary to restrict all carts, including red flag carts, to paths only. The Club will endeavor to minimize any inconvenience that this may create.

These relaxed cart rules are intended to aid the red flag user only and are not for the use of another person using the cart. Cart use to and from the other (passenger) person's ball shall conform to normal cart etiquette and rules of use.

The red flag should only be put into service by the designated user.
